- Different types of assignments including more discussion on "low stakes" assignments
- How to use technology (Moodle, polling software, AI) and grading inclusively
- People would want handouts and physical copies of some things discussed to take with them

Other comments and feedback (summarized from open-ended responses, n = 16)

- Important to demystify the myth that inclusion means lower expectations
- Appreciative comments about the virtual format and flow of information, good presentations, thankful for the
  time to discuss with colleagues, some responses about polling tech\*, one comment about not wanting to do the
  workshop over break time, faculty are already doing a lot of the things discussed in workshop
